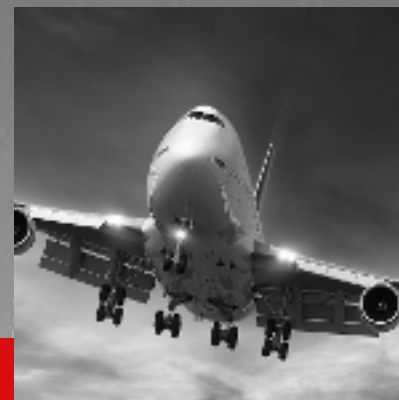

Renewal

Initial Requirements:

- ▶ On-line questionnaire to be completed with doctor
- ▶ Fasting lipids and glucose
- ▶ Spirometry (Lung Function)
- ▶ General medical examination
- ▶ ECG Urine test Audiogram (referral provided for external assessment)
- ▶ Ophthalmology review by Designated Aviation Ophthalmologist or Optometrist

Class 1 and Class 3 Aviation Medical appointments may require you to fast for four hours prior to your appointment. Fasting means no food but you may drink as much water as you like prior to the blood tests.

Renewal requirements vary depending on age and may include any combination of the above tests.

The Aviation Medical Certificate is valid for:

Class 1 – one year

Class 2 – four years (two years if over 40)

Class 3 – two years
